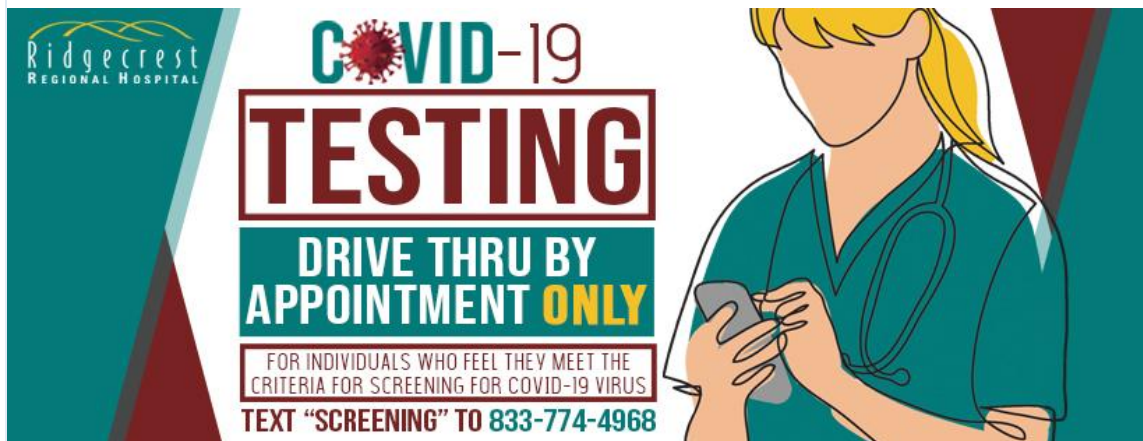

- A) Text "**SCREENING**" to **833-RRH-4YOU (833-774-4968)**
- B) The nursing triage line will contact you and review the screening algorithm with you
- C) If appropriate, we will direct you to the drive thru testing area for evaluation at an assigned appointment time.

The drive-thru testing area is located in the back parking lot of the hospital. BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.

RRH Launches Drive-Thru COVID-19 Screenings



Ridgecrest Regional Hospital (RRH) announced that it has established drive-thru testing for coronavirus (COVID-19) at the back parking lot of the main hospital campus, to help identify cases of COVID-19.

“The drive-thru process has been carefully designed to keep our patients and medical staff safe,” said Michelle Whalley, Clinic Administrator for the Rural Health Clinic. “Patients remain in their cars for the entire process and are only met up close by a doctor in full protective gear to minimize any potential exposure to infection.”

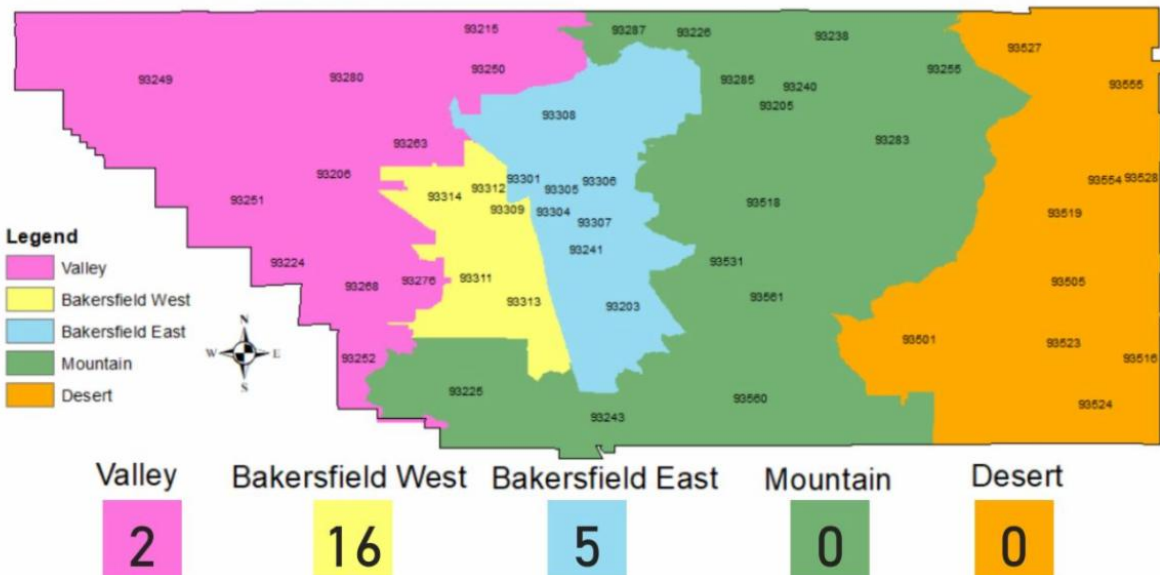
