The employees of Ridgecrest Regional Hospital came out to say We Love Our Hospital! Once again they said it with their financial support to RRH Development Foundation during our 2nd annual Employee Giving Campaign. In less than two years, 210 generous, grateful employees have given almost \$63,000. For most, their pledges to support the Hospital are ongoing payroll deductions.

"As an RRH employee, I couldn't be prouder of my co-workers. As the Executive Director of the Development Foundation I am inspired by the commitment of the Hospital's caring and giving employees and sincerely hope that the enthusiastic support of these individuals will motivate our community to a closer to a partnership with our Hospital."

During our campaign we always take time to address why we need a foundation and why we ask for the support of our community. Simply put, donated funds pay for things that otherwise would not be available unless the community steps in to assist.

For 2016, RRH Development Foundation is focusing on the purchase of an Ivenia<sup>™</sup> AVUS – the only breast cancer screening technology FDA-approved for detection in women with dense breast tissue. We know that 40% of women have dense breast tissue and that women with dense breast tissue have a substantially higher risk of developing breast cancer. The ABUS was specifically developed to help doctors find cancers hidden in dense breast tissue, which may be missed by mammography. Early detection is the key to helping women get the treatment they need to have the highest survival rate and we want to be a part of making that happen!

The Development Foundation office sits across the street from the hospital. "Each time / look across the street, / know that every minute of every day, patients and families are benefitting from the partnerships we are building with our community. As a donor myself, / know how gratifying it feels to be a part of Ridgecrest Regional Hospital, and you can too."

Our team includes sonographers, exercise physiologists, cardiopulmonary specialists, physicians and nurses.

# LABORATORY upgrade

Ridgecrest Regional Hospital unveiled a new, much larger lab facility with three check-in counters and a larger, more comfortable waiting area that can accommodate up to 20 patients at a time.

With the addition of extra check-in counters, patients can expect shorter wait times. To ease nervousness and anxiety of needle phobia, the new waiting area boasts 50 inch TV, a coffee and snack lounge and magazine racks to help keep patients engaged and calm.

Laboratory personnel at RRH consist of certified phlebotomists, laboratory assistants and licensed clinical laboratory scientists performing over 750,000 tests per year. The laboratory experts are part of the team that has been taking care of the community of Ridgecrest and the Southern Sierra Region for over 40 years. With accreditations from DNV and CAP the laboratory at RRH maintains strict standards of excellence.

- 2. Visit the link provided in discharge information and provide a valid e-mail address to begin registration process.
- 3. Upon completion of registration process, you will receive an email from Relay Health with activation link and information.
- 4. Click the link in your email and provide your date of birth to enter or access your medical information and records.

#### through the online patient portal, you may

- 1. Access health records online
- 2. Schedule and reschedule appointments
- 3. Request lab and test results
- 4. Request referrals to another doctor

And you may do it all on your mobile device!

Please Note: If you add any information to your personal health record, Ridgecrest Regional Hospital cannot access those changes. All questions regarding test results should be directed to the patients primary care or ordering physician.

From our point of view, Mr. Suver accomplished all of the Chamber's award criteria and more! The list of his accomplishments is lengthy, but here is a glimpse at some of the activities that earned him this award:

In 2009 Mr. Suver extended his expertise in finance, healthcare, construction and state and county building requirements, to ensure the final completion and opening of the RRH tower.

In 2012, Mr. Suver astonished the community by proposing RRH convert from an acute care facility to a critical access hospital. Time has proven that lateral transfers have remained minimal and because of Mr. Suver's business and financial leadership skills, the hospital has seen steady financial growth, resulting in additional jobs and services for our community. Today, Ridgecrest Regional Hospital is the second largest employer in our community.

Mr. Suver envisioned caring for the elderly as a community concern and directed Ridgecrest Regional Hospital to step in and fill the gap. Mr. Suver's vision came to fruition with the addition of a Transitional Care and Rehabilitation Unit or TCRU to Ridgecrest Regional Hospital's growing list of services, and the purchase and upgrades of the Skilled Nursing Facility now called Bella Sera.

Not only does Mr. Suver serve the needs of the community through the advancements of medicine and the expansion of the hospital, but he also supports local schools, programs and clubs within Ridgecrest, Inyokern and Trona.

In his role as Professor at Cal State Chico, he is developing future finance and healthcare leaders. As an educator he fully supports RRH employees in furthering their education as well as personally providing leadership training and open forums for all employees. His personal experience as Hospital Administrator and University Professor is an added quality as Mr. Suver takes the time to mentor and work with employees as well as offer internships for college students in a variety of positions.

The future of healthcare in Ridgecrest and its outlying communities has never looked better thanks to the leadership and vision of Jim Suver. He shows compassion and respect to all patients and uses his position to bring about positive changes and needed services to RRH. At the same time, he is always prepared to handle the unexpected and listen to ideas and suggestions.


