CASE STATEMENT RIDGECREST REGIONAL HOSPICE HOUSE

Our Mission

Since our first fundraising campaign in the spring of 2014, the Ridgecrest Regional Hospital Development foundation has, thanks to the generosity of our community, given back \$232,905 back to Ridgecrest Regional Hospital. This represents our contribution towards high definition endoscopy equipment, a portable ultrasound unit for the Emergency Department, and an automated

breast ultrasound system for the Women's Imaging department. The support of the Development Foundation, and the community, allows the hospital to acquire equipment it may not otherwise be able to purchase. And perhaps most importantly, for every dollar raised by the Development Foundation, the hospital's portion of the purchase is reduced, allowing the hospital to focus on other urgent needs.

The Challenge

Hospice is a special care provided to patients when cure-oriented treatments can no longer prolong life. It's goal is to improve quality of life by offering the patients comfort and dignity. Since 2008, Ridgecrest Regional Hospice fulfilled its mission of providing the best in compassionate, dignified care to individuals with terminal illnesses and their caregivers.

From time to time, it is not possible for a patient to receive care in their home, or in the home of family or friends. In this situation,

many reach out for care in a hospital or in a nursing home. This type of care is generally more expensive and less desirable for the terminally ill patient.

It has been a long held dream of the team at Ridgecrest Regional Hospice to open and operate a hospice house here in Ridgecrest. It is their dream that inspired the RRH Development Foundation to open the Butterfly Boutique to raise money for hospice; and, it is their dream that motivated us to adopt our current fundraising effort to open that hospice house.

Our Solution

Our proposal...to purchase a local home, convert the space into a 4-6 bed free-standing hospice residential facility where individuals may experience compassionate and dignified end-of-life care in a homelike setting.

Costs

While it is not possible to anticipate the actual costs in advance, we have been asked by Ridgecrest Regional Hospital to contribute \$300,000 to make this dream a reality.
