

RESTRICTED VISITING POLICY

(ENGLISH)

Restricted Visiting Policy:

To protect our patients, staff and community during this Coronavirus pandemic the following restrictions are in place. Routine visiting is suspended until further notice.

The following exceptions are in place:

- Pediatric patients are allowed to have 1 support person with them at all times.
- Labor and Delivery patients are allowed to have 1 support person with them at all times.
- Patients with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities, and/or cognitive impairments are allowed to have 1 support person when medically necessary (provides safety, and/or integral part of the care team)
- Emergency Department – no visitors allowed unless any of the exception criteria exists.

End of Life:

Patients who are nearing end of life will be allowed to have 2 visitors. This will be arranged through nursing/nursing supervisor.

- Non-COVID patients – family will be required to wash hands prior to entering the room and a wear a mask. Must stay in room.
- COVID positive patients – Family will be required to wear personal protective equipment (PPE). This includes gown, gloves, eye protection and procedure mask. Nursing staff will assist in donning and doffing of PPE. Must stay in room.

All visitors will be required to pass the screening process. No one will be allowed in the facility who does not pass.

RRH encourages frequent telephone calls and video chats for the patients and families to stay connected during these difficult times.

RRH is following the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) most current guidelines for visitors. AFL 20-38.4.
